
# The European Parliament





#### WHY?

To address the **significant underrepresentation** of Austrian nationals among Parliament staff Article 27 of the Staff Regulations and GIPs

#### WHAT?

**Competition** (grade AD 6) to draw up a list of suitable candidates of **Austrian nationals Enlarge the talent pool** of possible future recruits
No posts shall be reserved for nationals of any specific Member State

Target: 30 suitable candidates

#### • WHERE?

European Parliament's posts are mainly based in Brussels, Luxembourg and Strasbourg

### Who can apply?

#### **General criteria**


- Be a national of the Republic of Austria
- Enjoy **full rights** as a citizen



- Have fulfilled any obligations imposed on you by the laws on military service
- Provide suitable character references demonstrating capability for the duties required

#### **Specific criteria**

• University studies of at least **three years**, attested by a **diploma** officially recognised in one of the Member States of the EU



• Thorough knowledge of German, and a satisfactory knowledge of one of the other 23 EU official languages

### How is this competition organised?

The **competition** is based on tests. It consists of **two stages**:

- 1. Pre-selection (MCQ test) and eligibility check
  - Computer-based MCQ test
  - Check of specific eligibility criteria



#### 2. Tests

- Drafting test
- Interview
