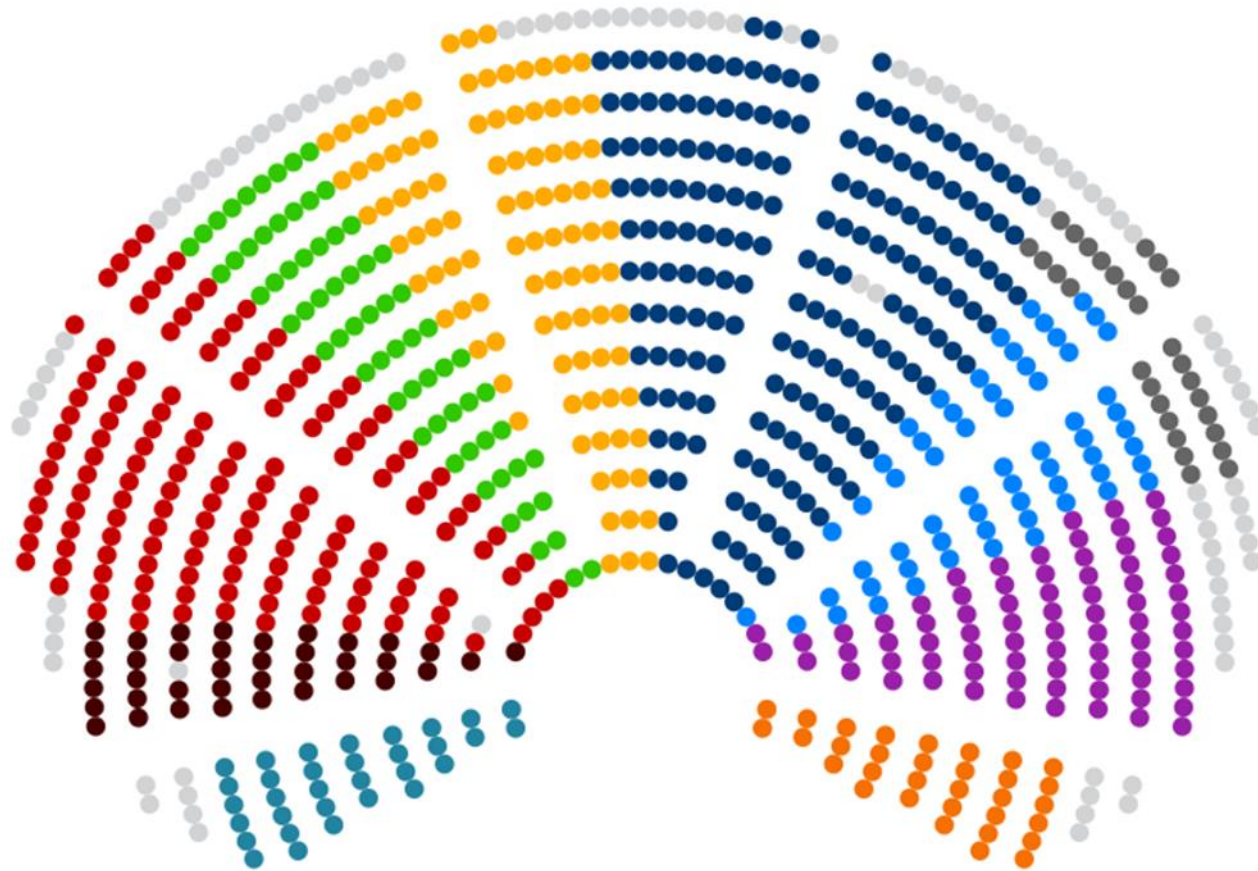


The European Parliament

705 MEPs

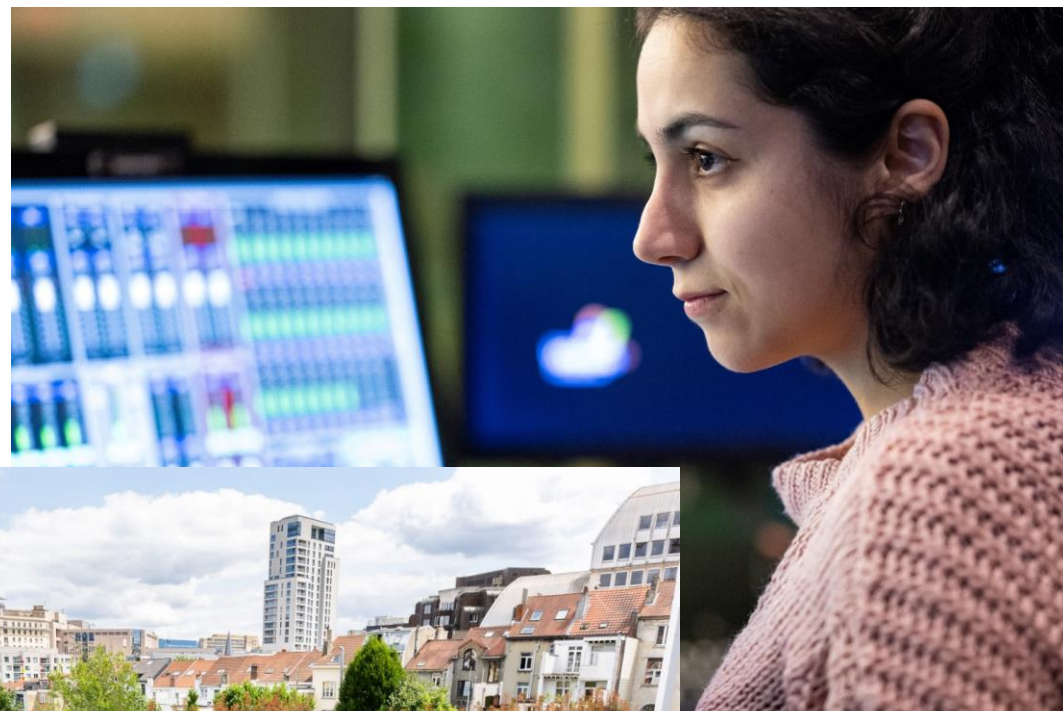

Impact



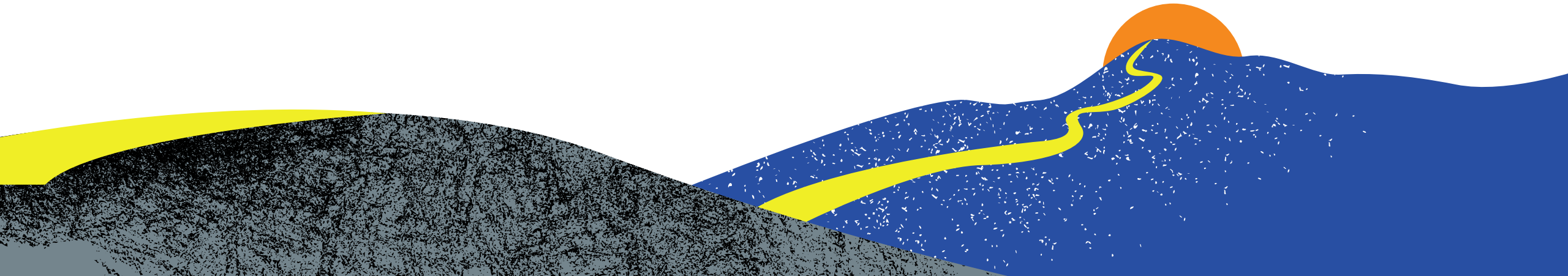
- Co-legislator of most EU legislation

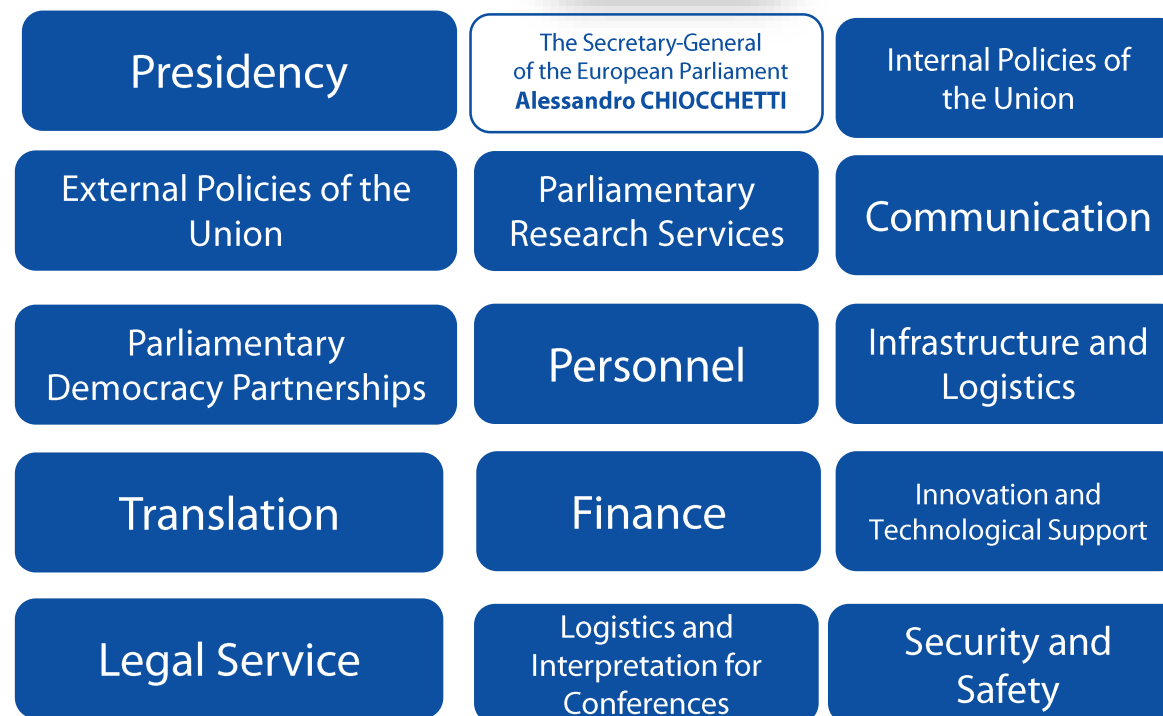

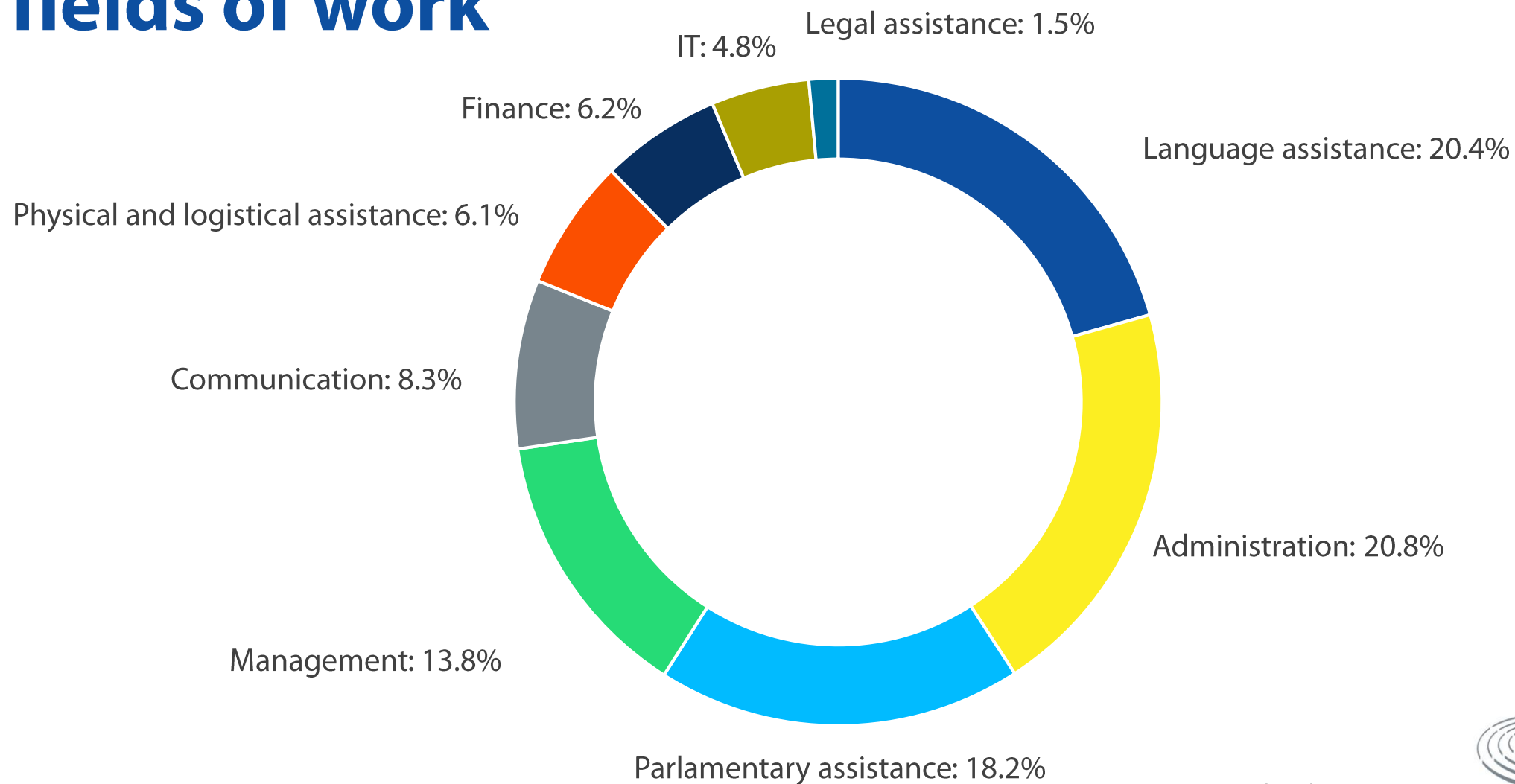
- As staff of the European Parliament, we **empower Members of the European Parliament** for a resilient and effective European democracy.
- Every member of staff, directly or indirectly, **works for** the benefit of **EU citizens** in a **wide range of areas**.



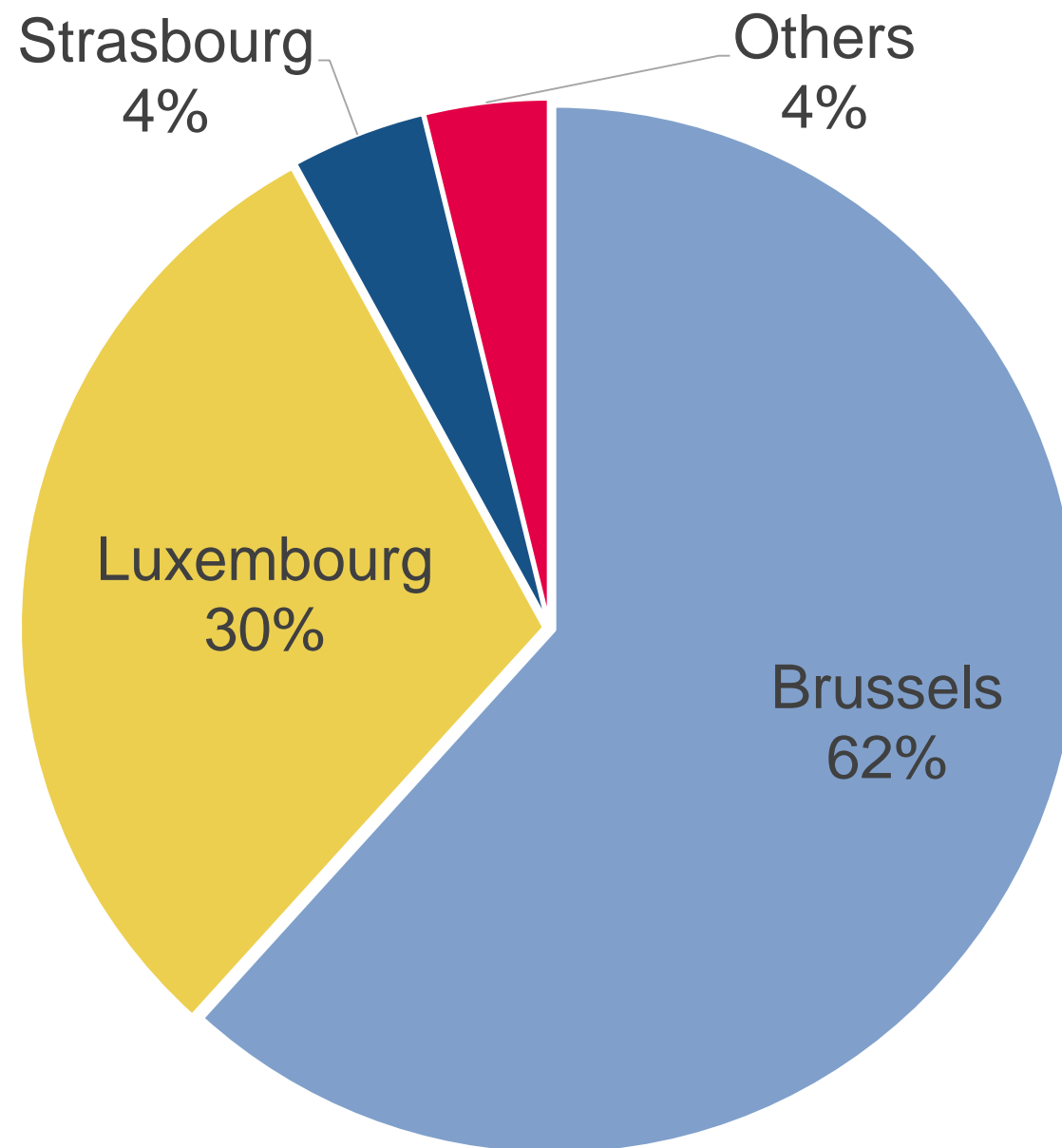

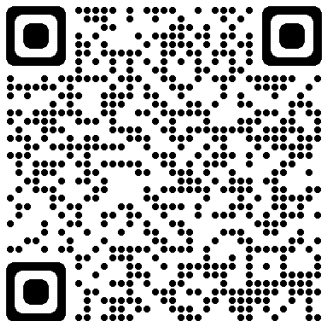

EPSO

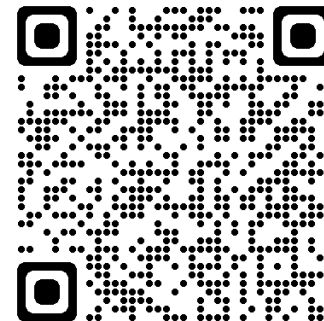


- **European Personnel Selection Office** selects staff for all EU institutions and agencies

General information



- **WHY ?**

To address the **significant underrepresentation** of Austrian nationals among Parliament staff
Article 27 of the Staff Regulations and GIPs

- **WHAT ?**

Competition (grade AD 6) to draw up a list of suitable candidates of **Austrian nationals**

Enlarge the talent pool of possible future recruits

No posts shall be reserved for nationals of any specific Member State

- Target : **30 suitable candidates**




- **WHERE ?**

European Parliament's posts are mainly based in **Brussels, Luxembourg and Strasbourg**




What do administrators do ?

Administrators in the Secretariat of the European Parliament carry out management, planning and research duties in a **wide range of areas**:




- Provision of advice and support to Members of the European Parliament (MEPs) and parliamentary bodies 
- Resources management
- Law 
- Information and communication policy
- IT, IT security and security 
- Project management

Who can apply ?

General criteria

- Be a national of the **Republic of Austria**
- Enjoy **full rights** as a citizen 
- Have fulfilled **any obligations** imposed on you by the laws on military service
- Provide suitable **character references** demonstrating capability for the duties required

Specific criteria

- University studies of at least **three years**, attested by a **diploma** officially recognised in one of the Member States of the EU 
- At least **two years' professional experience** (post university diploma) relevant to the activities listed in the job description 
- **Thorough** knowledge of **German**, and a **satisfactory** knowledge of one of the other 23 **EU official languages** 



How is this competition organised?

The **competition** is based on tests. It consists of **two stages**:

1. Pre-selection (**MCQ test**) and **eligibility check**

- Computer-based MCQ test
- Check of specific eligibility criteria



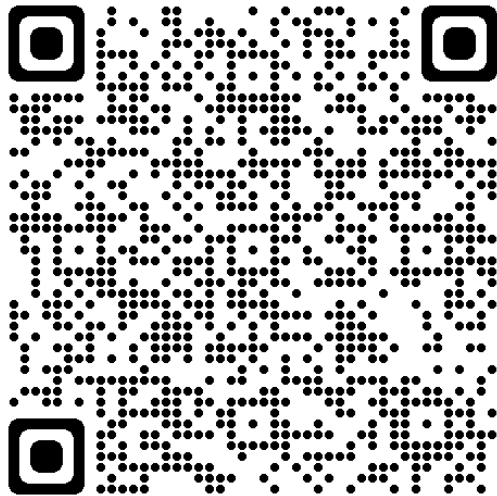
2. Tests

- Drafting test
- Interview
